ODM's Current Coverage



How does ODM pay for group pregnancy education now?

- ODM currently covers basic group pregnancy education
 » S9436, S9437, S9444, S9452
 - In CY19, ODM paid for 3700 services to 2100 women for \$30k

ODM also paid Centering orgs \$4.4M over SFY20-21 to serve
 3900 women



How does ODM pay for group pregnancy education now?

Coverage of Group Pregnancy Education Services Rendered at an FQHC or RHC

- Covered non-PPS services
 - » Group services do not meet the definition of an FQHC or RHC service or a 'visit', which are paid under the PPS
- Group services are paid under an FQHC or RHC's "clinic" provider number (50)
 - » An FQHC or RHC is required to enroll separately in Medicaid as another type of provider and to use a non-FQHC Medicaid provider number in order to receive separate payment for a service or supply that cannot be claimed as an FQHC service or RHC as defined in rules 5160-28-03.1 and 3.3
 - Payment amounts listed in fee schedule
 - Covered non-PPS services are not reported on claims for wraparound payments



How does ODM pay for group pregnancy education in an O/P Setting now?

- Procedure codes S9436, S9437, and S9444 group to EAPG 999
 Unassigned
- Procedure code S9452 groups to EAPG 490 Incidental to Medical Visit or Significant Procedure
- Costs associated with these services are included with payable services when ODM determines EAPG relative weights
- Professional services can be billed separately for reimbursement

Other ways group pregnancy providers bill for services

- 9921X office/outpatient visit
- S9447 infant safety
- S9453 smoking cessation
- S9470 prenatal nutritional counseling (if a dietitian was present)
- H1002 prenatal care coordination every 28 days

(All of these codes are billed with a TH modifier)

Group Pregnancy Education Proposed Changes

- ODM is increasing rates for evidence-informed group pregnancy education services
- ODM is adding POS '99-Other' to all group pregnancy CPT/HCPCS codes
- ODM will cover:
 - » 12 sessions per pregnancy max
 - Each session is at least one hour
 - » 2-20 individuals per group (This does not include spouses and other support persons)

Group Pregnancy Education Proposed Changes

- ODM is adding coverage for evidence-based group prenatal education
 - » 99078
 - TH modifier to indicate prenatal
 - » \$45 rate per encounter (each encounter must be at least one and half hours)
 - » 12 sessions per pregnancy max
 - » 20 individuals max per group
 - Must bill an appropriate E&M code for prenatal care for the same individual on the same DOS (99211, 99212, or 99213)

Who is ODM proposing to provide group pregnancy education?

- Rendering providers*
 - » Physicians
 - » Physician's assistants
 - » Advanced practice registered nurses
- Billing Providers
 - » Physicians
 - » Physician assistants
 - » Advanced practice registered nurses
 - » Professional medical groups
 - » Ambulatory health care clinics
 - » Federally qualified health care clinics
 - » Rural health clinics
 - » Outpatient hospitals

^{*}Other licensed practitioners (e.g. registered nurse or dietitian) may perform these services under the supervision of one of the rendering practitioners above

- Group pregnancy education currently covered under Pregnancy Related Services OAC rule 5160-21-04
 - » Changes have been made to the rule text to expand coverage to cover evidencebased AND evidence-informed group prenatal education
 - » Medicaid Advisory Letter (MAL) will be published describing covered services and guidance for claim submission
 - » Appendix DD will be updated to reflect the new codes and rates

- (b) Group pregnancy education (the face-to-face presentation by a medical professional to a group of two or more participants but no more than twenty participants excluding partners, spouses, or coaches) in a session that may consist of one or more classes. Group pregnancy education provides information utilizing culturally sensitive communication and facilitates family-centered collaboration and support. Group pregnancy education classes will meet the following criteria: and cover any of five subject areas related to at-risk pregnancy:
 - » (i)Cover subjects related to pregnancy, including:
 - (a) Childbirth preparation (e.g., Lamaze);
 - (b) Childbirth refresher;
 - (c) Nutrition;
 - (d) Parenting; and
 - (e) Infant safety; or
 - » (ii)Consist of an evidence-based or evidence-informed curriculum that has been demonstrated to result in improved health outcomes and/or improved health equity for pregnant and postpartum women and their infants.

- MISP rule changes will be posted for public comment within the next couple of weeks
